The play had its premiere on 14 November 2012 at the Royal National Theatre's Cottesloe Theatre. The script was adapted by Robin Herford from the French play, Les Remparts de l'aventure by Christophe Grangier, based on the 1920s film The Secret of the Sahara by Harry d'Abbadie d'Arrast. Synopsis The play takes place in Tangier, a city on the Moroccan coast of the Mediterranean Sea, and the world of its expatriate population, during a time of changing political and social order. In 1916, British war correspondent Roland MacIvor is on assignment in Tangier where he is working on a book about the recent outbreak of the First World War. His work is interrupted by a mysterious man who enters his hotel and declares himself to be an English secret agent named George Brent. He claims to have tracked MacIvor down to Tangier to deliver a message for his government. They are both captured by a French police inspector and taken to a secret prison, and the pair soon find themselves with an escapee from the French hospital where the doctor is incarcerated. In the end, a physician who has come to the hospital, has a hidden agenda of his own. Differences between the play and the film Some changes were made to adapt the film version to a stage production. The main difference is the omission of the character of Lord Redesdale, who was only in the film version. The character of Lady Redesdale was reduced from a major character to a background role. The roles of Mme Belinde, Mme Belinde's mother, and of Albert [Sir Archibald] Eliot were also reduced or changed. In the play the character of MacIvor was renamed Roland Macdonald. In the play, MacIvor was also accompanied by an American named Claude Shannon. The character of Shannon was omitted in the adaptation. The character of Madame Belinde was also reduced. The French police inspector and the doctor were also renamed. The dialogue was also changed from the film version. The role of the French police inspector, Le Chauffard, was changed to M. Robert. The doctor's name was changed to Dr. Lhermitte, and the doctor's wife's name was changed to Madame Dupont. The character of George Brent was also added.
